

Addison Water Works
 “LEAK POLICY”
 Adopted: June 6, 2005
 Amended: September 21, 2009

This would be a one time per year, per meter adjustment. The leak will have to increase the previous 3 month average of the customers’ bill by \$300.00. The adjustment on the leak amount would be billed at the current rate Addison Water Works pays for the water they purchase. Customer should notify Addison Water Works in the event a water leak occurs. Customer must have a valid receipt from a plumber or valid receipt where parts were purchased to fix leak before adjustment can be made. This is offered to residential customers only. In the event a customer has a leak and can show proof, they will be given three months to pay the leak amount of bill.

The \$300.00 needs to be over the customers **previous** 3 month average.

Example: Bill amount with leak \$544.80	104,400 gallons
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Previous 3 month average at normal price \$23.00	1600 gallons
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1900 gallons
1600 gallons
- <u>1400 gallons</u>
4900 gallons divided by 3 = 1600 gallons

104,400	take total gallons from leak and subtract 3 month average gallons from this
- <u>1,600</u>	
102,800	take total and times it by what we pay for water

102,800 x \$2.30 = \$236.44 customer will pay what we currently pay for these gallons

23.00	customers pays regular price for 3 month average
+ <u>236.44</u>	
259.44	

\$ 259.44 x (4% utility tax) \$ 10.37 = \$ 269.81 adjusted bill amount
